Halesworth Area Community Transport (HACT) provides the 511 bus service in and around Halesworth and Holton connecting them to the GP surgery, the Co-op supermarket, railway station and the Thoroughfare. It is manned by friendly and helpful volunteer drivers and offers bus buddies in the mornings who can assist passengers on and off the bus and offer advice on transport connections and local events and activities.

The 511 route is served by 16-seater disabled-accessible buses. It is like any other route. Passengers pay a fare or use a concessionary bus pass and can hail the Hoppa anywhere along its route. If necessary, drivers can use their own discretion to divert off the main route for a short distance or to take those with impaired mobility closer to their door. Please call us by 9:15am on 01986 875900 if you need assistance, or if you are off route.

The 511 bus service runs Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday, Friday and Saturday 9:30am to 12:30pm and Tuesday afternoons 1:45pm to 3:30pm.

There is no service on Thursdays.
